About the University (SVPUAT)

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel University of Agriculture & Technology has the unique distinction of being called the “First Agriculture University of 21st Century”. The university was established on 2nd October 2000 under Uttar Pradesh University Act (revised) 1958 gazette and notified vide 3204A/X12-8-2000. There are seven constituent colleges viz., College of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (COVAS), College of Agriculture, College of Biotechnology, College of Horticulture, College of Post Harvest Technology, College of Technology & College of Sugarcane Science & Technology, 20 Krishi Vigyan Kendra and 1 Krishi Gyan Kendra. About Meerut

Meerut an ancient city situated between the holy rivers Ganga and Yamuna has been an important centre of human activities since the very early times of Vedic Civilisation. The city lies 70 km northeast of the national capital New Delhi and 453 km northwest of the state capital Lucknow. It is well connected by rail and road with major cities. Meerut derives its name from the word “Maya Rashtra”, the country of Maya, the architect of the asuras (the demons) as per the Hindu mythology. Mandodari, the daughter of Maya was the wife of Ravana. Hastinapur, the capital of the Kauravas is situated in present day Meerut District. Besides, Meerut has played a significant role in the freedom struggle of our country with the first sepoy mutiny of 1857 starting here. The city is also known for its sports and musical instruments. The University is situated 10 km from the city. The weather in the month of November will be pleasant to moderately cold with the temperature fluctuating between 25 °C in the day and 15 °C at night. Light woolen clothes in morning and evening may be required.

Transport

The University is located approximately 93 km from New Delhi. The nearest airport is New Delhi Airport, officially known as Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi. The various private taxi services are available directly from airport to the University. The University is 12 km away from Meerut City Railway Station and 7 km away from Meerut Cantt. which can be easily covered by frequent taxi or auto e-rickshaw services.

It should contain the title, contributing authors along with the affiliation, address and email. The abstract should clearly indicate the aim of research, experimental design, results obtained, discussion and brief conclusion. It should be in MS word, font: Times New Roman, font size 12 with word limits 250. The last date for submission of abstract and invited papers is October 31, 2024.
