- 2. 4. Bid Price

- 5. Each bidder shall submit only one quotation.

6. Validity of Quotation

Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than 30 days after the deadline date specified for submission.

7. Evaluation of Quotations

The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which

- (a) are properly signed; and
- (b) conform to the terms and conditions, and specifications.

The Quotations would be evaluated separately for each item. Sales tax in connection with sale of goods shall not be taken into account in evaluation.

8. Award of contract

The Purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated quotation price.

- 8.1 Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract.
- 8.2 The bidder whose bid is accepted will be notified of the award of contract by the Purchaser prior to expiration of the quotation validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the purchase order.
- 9. Payment shall be made immediately after delivery of the goods.
- 10. Normal commercial warranty/ guarantee shall be applicable to the supplied goods.
- 11. You are requested to provide your offer to undersigned by registered/speed post or deposit in the office of Dean, College of Biotechnology by 17.00 hours on 20/03/2021.
- 12. The firms interested in quotation should send separate quotation in sealed envelope. Each quotation should be placed in a separate envelope. No combined application will be entertained. The name of the item "LABORATORY MODERNIZATION" should be written on envelope in bold letters.
